
Series of 10 diptych portraits based on a three months research period with five visiting nurses in the Netherlands and their clients.

A violent incident is observed from a distance. With multiple prints of 6 different litho stones the act is made into an analogy: a tragic slapstick concealed by the everyday.

With this work I reflected on my role as an artist at places of care, by looking back at my residency at Het Vijfde Seizoen, at psychiatric clinic Willem Arentz Hoeve in 2016.



5. *Summerschool* 2017-2019 (selection of documentation)

Summerschool Programs *Push Here* (2017), *My Other Tongue* (2018) and *Model 2050* (2019) in Amsterdam (*Beautiful Distress House*), Utrecht (*Casco*) and Den Dolder (*het Vijfde Seizoen*). Young artists learned about the domain of psychiatry by an intensive Ten-day Summer School with guest artists, clients, theorists, psychiatrists

and advisors Dirk van Lieshout and Marieke Zwart. Participants make a new work and exhibit their researches in the Summerschool Exhibitions. The Summerschool of Het Vijfde Seizoen was first set up by Esther Vossen, Dirk van Lieshout and Marieke Zwart in 2017. Guest speakers were a.o: Roy Villevoeye (artist),

Maria Barnas (artist), Saskia Janssen (artist), Anke Bangma (Director Tent Rotterdam), Wilco Tuinebreijer (psychiatrist), Roxanne Vernimmen (Head of the Board of OLVG). Publication *Summer Schools, Artist Programs on Mental Health* published in 2019 by *Het Vijfde Seizoen*.




6. *Interview 2018 (overview)*

Installation with doorzonwoning scale model at 60%, video on screen and slide projection with two house fly wings. approx. 3,5m x 3 m x 5,5m

An installation based around an interview with Indies veteran Toon Segers, in a theatrical model of a typical Dutch house, the doorzonwoning. After I met Toon in an earlier project, and had many coffees with him in his house in Nootdorp, I learned he suffered from

nightmares about the war in Indonesia. I was interested to hear more about his experiences there and how they have influenced his life. Toon was sharing very little information about the specifics of his actions (and of his companions).

With this installation I presented his silence in the context of the Dutch architectural dream of transparency and modernism, that the doorzonwoning represents.









Performative reading with shirt story *Vliegen* and projected house fly wings. The story is available via these links in [English](#) or [Dutch](#).

The first (wooden) houses at the Nieuwendijk were built around 1225. They were the oldest residential houses of Amsterdam. I have been living on the remains for over ten years now. The street has never been as desolate as it was during the first lockdown of Covid -19 in 2020. In my head the street changed into a river.

11. *Professional Amateur, by depend on me research group 2022 (overview presentation at puntWG)*


10 day presentation at puntWG March 2022, showcasing five artistic collaborations between professional and non-professional artists in Amsterdam.

depend one me was a research program and artist group, initiated by artist Marieke Zwart, that facilitates artistic collaborations between professional and non-professional artists, funded by AFK. Over the course of 7 months, 10 artists from professional, semi-professional and amateur art-practices created a new work and research how to collaborate horizontally and interdependently as


artists from different contexts and generations. Next to the creation of new art works, our research consisted of a trajectory with workshops, talks, feedback sessions and presentations, both public and among the research members. For every workshop we made new relations in the city with other artists groups, professional art institutes and amateur art associations.
